I guess we'll just have to find out.































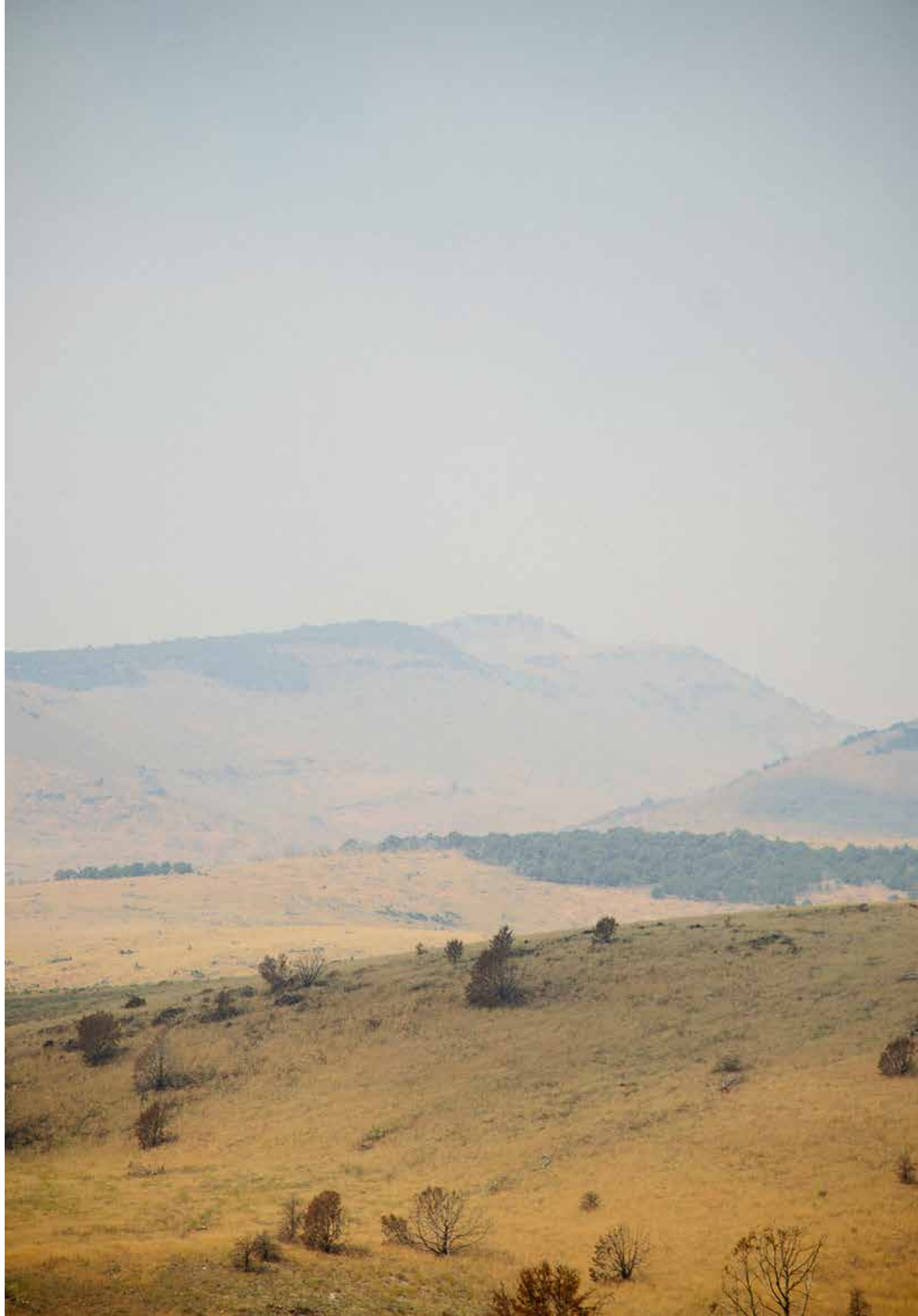
